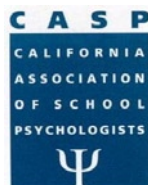
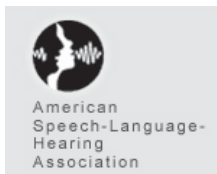

Sally Rogers is a developmental psychologist, a professor of psychiatry at the M.I.N.D. Institute, University of California, Davis. She is the principal investigator of several autism research projects and is on the editorial boards of several peer-reviewed journals and other publications. In addition to research, she has developed an intervention model that is used internationally and works closely with school districts to develop best practice programs.
